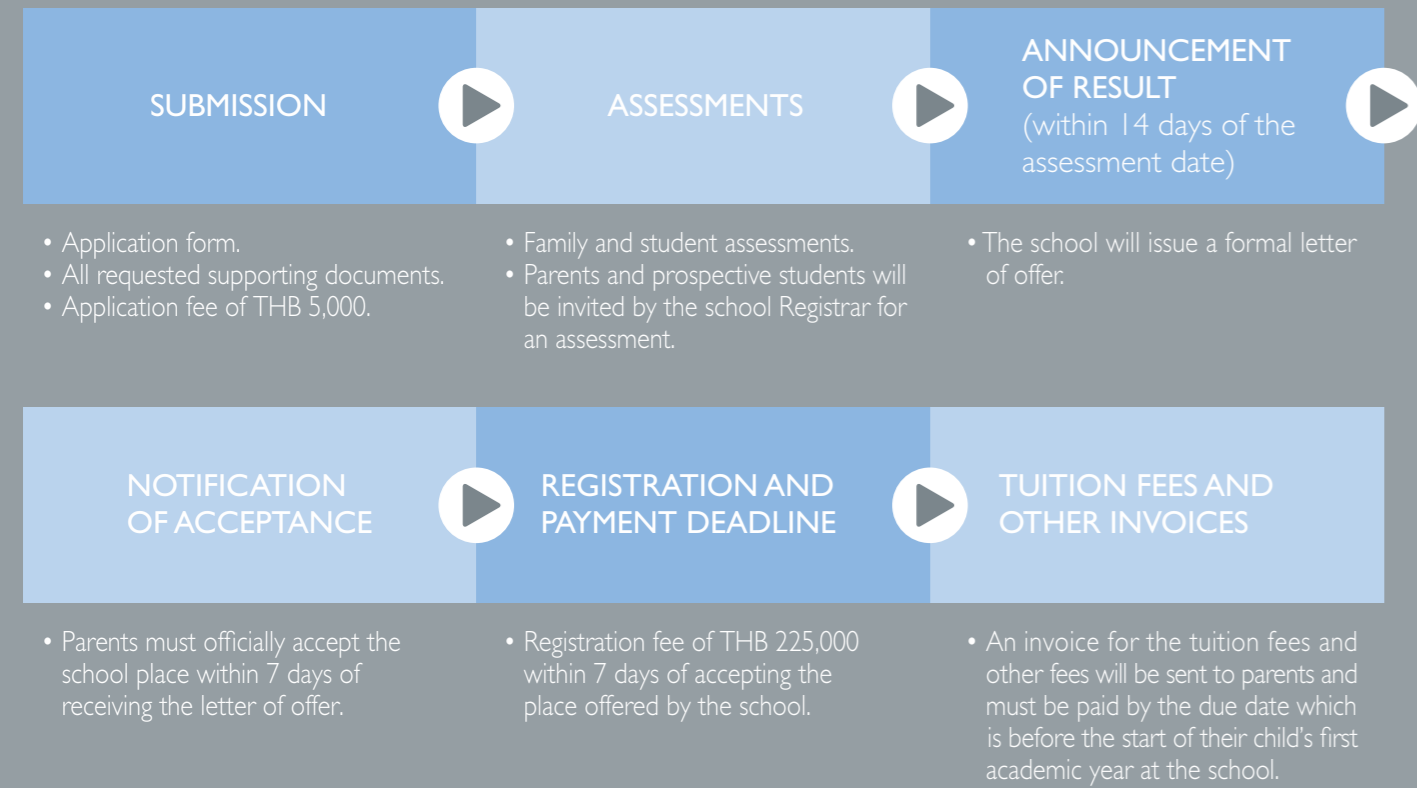

This is to observe the child's general readiness for school and social interactions with both adults and other children. During this time, the child will also be invited to work with a trained adult on simple one-to-one exercises and to discuss a book or topic together. Parents are invited to an interview lasting up to 20 minutes while their child plays independently. (Total duration is approximately one hour.) At this time, parents are required to pay the THB 5,000 application fee.	All children are assessed in small groups of two to six. The child will be invited to play within this group without parent supervision. Each child will have a one-to-one assessment with a member of the Admissions Team on maths, phonics and reading. The assessment will end with a whole-group session to observe social interactions, focus and the ability to follow instructions. (Total duration is approximately one hour.)
