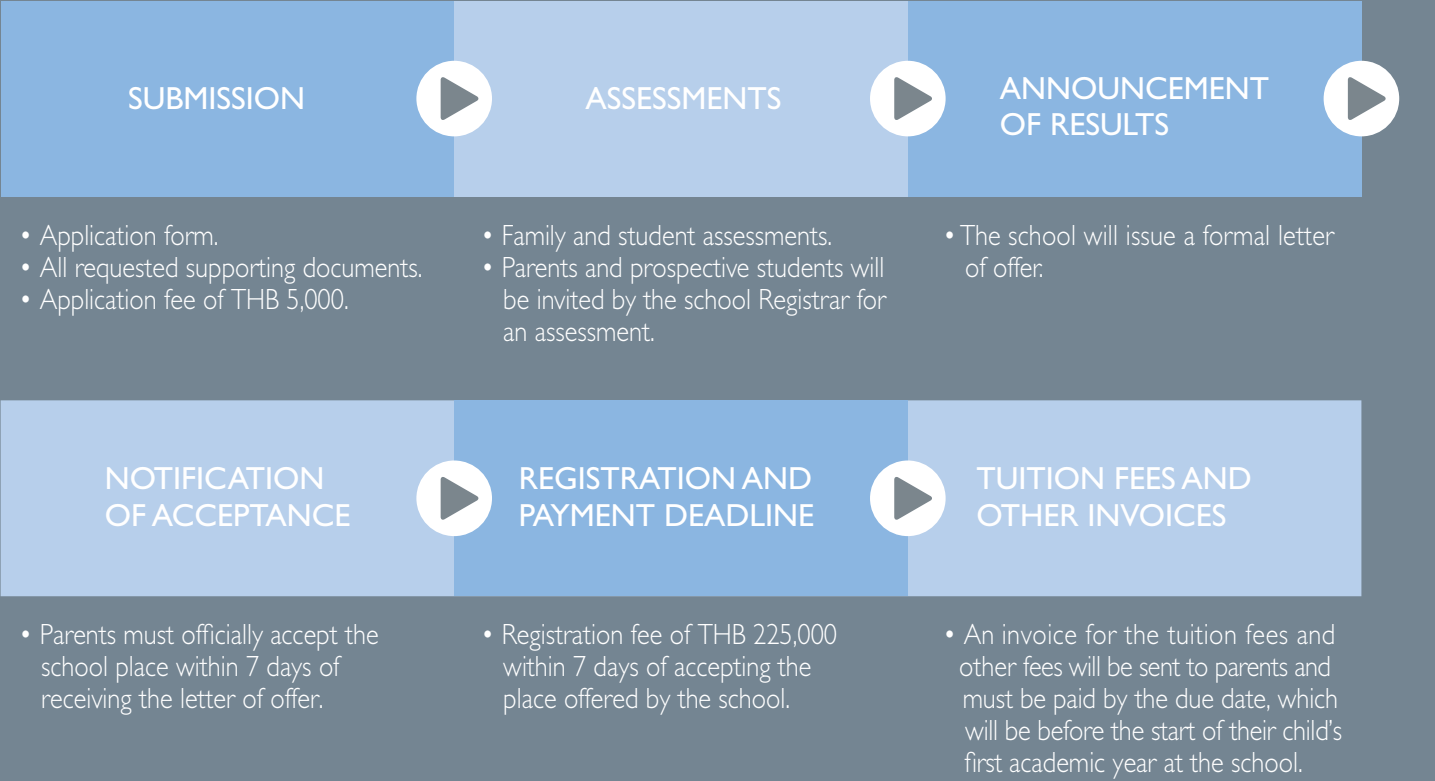

## APPLICATION



\* For families and prospective students who are applying from abroad or who are unable to visit the campus in person, we are able to offer online assessments. We would like to facilitate the admissions process for families who have not yet been able to visit us in person and can provide these details upon request.

\* The entry point of the school is at the beginning of the academic year, or in some cases, when Term 2 or 3 starts. Exceptions to this may be approved on occasion by the Headmaster for special circumstances.
