TUITION FEES AND

- Parents must officially accept the school place within 7 days of receiving the letter of offer.
- Registration fee of THB 225,000 within 7 days of accepting the place offered by the school.
- An invoice for the tuition fees and other fees will be sent to parents and must be paid by the due date, which will be before the start of their child first academic year at the school.
- * For families and prospective students who are applying from abroad or who are unable to visit the campus in person, we are able to offer online assessments. We would like to facilitate the admissions process for families who have not yet been able to visit us in person and can provide these details upon request.
- * The entry point of the school is at the beginning of the academic year, or in some cases, when Term 2 or 3 starts. Exception to this may be approved on occasion by the Headmaster for special circumstances.

Children will be expected to take an online cognitive aptitude test, do a creative writing exercise and do a short interview. (Total duration approximately three hours, with breaks given between each assessment.)

Supporting documents will have been submitted with the application form. Any further supporting materials (eg details of any learning needs or medical conditions) must be submitted on the day of assessment. Parents will be interviewed either during their child's assessment or shortly following the assessment.

Offers of a place will be sent via letter and email. Parents will be asked to fill in the letter of acceptance, and they will be invoiced the non-refundable THB 225,000 registration fee. If offered a place on the waitlist, parents will be asked to pay a waitlist fee instead.
